

Those eligible for the Maryland Dream Act:

- Attended a Maryland high school for at least three years, starting no earlier than the 2005-2006 school year;
- Graduated from a Maryland high school or received a Maryland GED, no earlier than the 2007-2008 school year;
- Registered at a Maryland community college within four years of high school graduation or receiving a Maryland GED
- Provide documentation that the student or the student's parent or legal guardian has filed a Maryland income tax return annually while the student attended high school/community college
